What is an IDS meeting like? IDS meetings follow a number of different formats, but they always include an educational activity about daffodils or gardening with daffodils. These activities may be a spoken presentation, a slide show, a hands-on workshop, a demonstration or a panel discussion. There is always an opportunity to ask questions, and since most IDS members grow a large variety of plants in their gardening activities, you can be sure to learn a lot about all kinds of gardening.
